## "Starry village, Ashibetsu"

Overlooking the beautiful starry sky as it descends.

Showa 63 (1988) January 30, the Ministry of the Environment (Environment Agency at the time) recognized Ashibetsu City and it became a "Starry Sky Town" in the "Starry Sky Town / Blue Sky City Contest". 89% of the city area is thickly forested blocking the clear air from the forest and the surrounding light so that the surrounding mountains create an environment that can be called a natural planetarium. If you go a little out of the city you can see the meaning of the name of "Starry Village". There are few street lamps in the night of Ashibetsu, and it is the best way to see the beautiful stars in the northern country.

To take photos of the starry sky with a smartphone, the phone camera alone is not suitable. It is best to use a tripod, a remote, and a special app.

You will need an app on your smartphone that allows you to reduce shutter speed, a tripod to fit your smartphone onto, and a way to take photos by remote control.

## Why are the stars So beautiful In Ashibetsu?

"Ashibetsu has a very large overall land area, but its  
population density is low and there are few city lights.  
And since about 90% of the area is a forested mountain,  
that mountain becomes a wall and the surrounding city  
lights are shut out.

The air is also clear due to the purification effect of the  
large forest. Ashibetsu has the conditions to see the stars clearly."

Yamakasa's main event, Oiyama, is a timed race in which Yamakasa is carried. It's a wonderful time to come and experience the Kenka Festival.

Three streams, Rokkou Nagare, Sakae Nagare and Kita-Daikoku Nagare, flow along the mountain. In addition, the Shi Nagare centered on the city hall is divided into three and helps each style. When the Yamakasa, weighing almost one ton, is moved from the station to the starting point, I was first excited by the shout "Oisa!" During the countdown that tells you to start, the nervous tension wraps around the venue.

Then, at the moment of the long-awaited start, Yamakasa starts running at once with a bigger shout of "Oisa!" You can even feel the road shaking at speeds faster than you think. This is the most exciting moment.

When the sun goes down, the event finally starts. Live music will be performed by the musicians on the stage and they will head to the grand finale. It is a fusion of 5,000 fireworks, laser lights and music. Just before the fireworks begin, smoke spreads out in the venue, and you may think, "What's going on?" This plays the role of a screen that enhances the effect of the laser beams. The floating smoke creates a fantastic atmosphere and the excitement of the launch increases. Overheard conversations that are full of expectation - "I wonder what is coming?" The time of excitement is coming.

Lasers draw various graphics in sync with the music, and the peoples' heads are colored and everyone enjoys watching. After a break, the long-awaited fireworks launch! These fireworks are like a mountain just in front of you, not to mention the number of fireworks. Because it is very close to the audience, it is attractive that you can enjoy the power of the air vibrating with the sound of the launch.

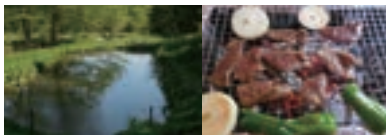

This Orchard, the pride of Ashibetsu, has been featured in magazines and on TV .

The cherry trees spread all over. The 47,000-square-meter rain dome, larger than Tokyo Dome, is the largest in Japan and can accommodate about 1,000 people at a time. First-time visitors will be amazed by the vastness and greenhouses that fill the orchard. Thanks to this greenhouse, care has been taken to allow cherry picking even on rainy days.

There are about 60 varieties of cherries in the garden, one of the largest cherry orchards in the country, and they are safely grown without the use of chemical fertilizers.

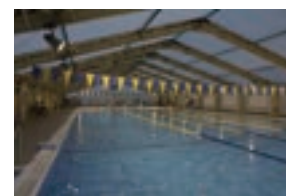

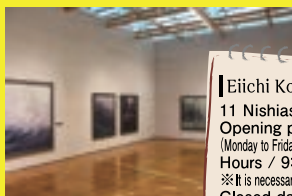

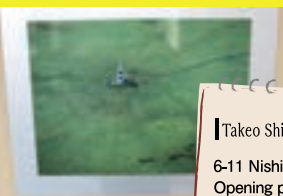

Giant sacred tree over 1,700 years old "Golden Mill Park" - The estimated age of 1,700 years, and the height of the tree is 21 meters, with a diameter of 6.2 meters. The big Yew Tree is called "Golden Yew (Kogane water pine)". "Mizumatsu" is another name for Yew, and boasts the eighth largest nationwide. Many people pray for good health, as it is popular as a sacred tree.

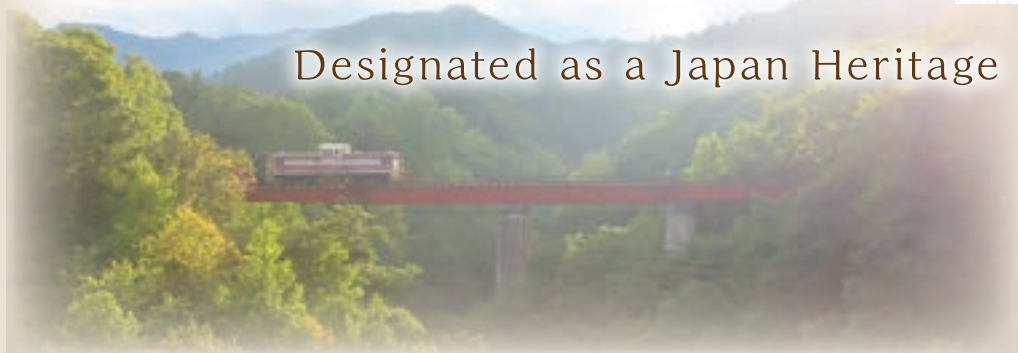

About the northern industrial revolution "Coal Iron Port" that greatly contributed to the development of Hokkaido, such as Sorachi's coal mine heritage, Muroran factory landscape, Otaru port and railway facilities in various places, 12 cities and towns in Hokkaido including Ashibetsu City (promotion of coal iron port) The Council) submitted a Japan Heritage application to the Hokkaido Board of Education on January 8, 2019 with the aim of registering it as a Japan Heritage, and was certified as a Japan Heritage on May 20, 2019. Seisa University (formerly Yoriyo Elementary School) school building and gymnasium in Ashibetsu City, and the former Mitsui Ashibetsu Railway Tanzan Bridge have been certified as "constituent cultural properties" of this "coal iron port".

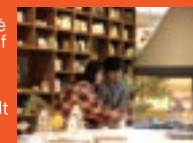

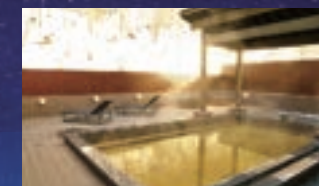
